Milwaukee Valve Company was founded in 1901 and acquired by the Seder Family in 1959 and they remain as sole owners of the company.

Milwaukee Valve Company has been supplying valves to the Navy's shipbuilding industry for just over 40 years since the early 1960s. Our customer base includes all of the Northrop Grumman Ship System companies - Newport News, Avondale and Ingalls, all of the General Dynamics companies - Electric Boat, Bath Iron Works and NASSCO as well Marinette Marine. We also sell direct to the government groups DSCC and NAVICP.



MARKETS SERVED

Milwaukee Valve Company serves four primary markets Marine, Commercial, Industrial and Plumbing. The company serves those four primary markets with three different brands Milwaukee, Marine and Hammond.

Milwaukee Valve has recently expanded its product offering to include titanium gate, globe, check and ball valves. Also, we have expanded to include stainless steel gate, globe and check valves. The breadth of our existing line was increased to include 250 # globe valves and 10” – 16” gate valves. Most recently we have expanded our bronze ball valve line.
