



## **GENERAL BACKGROUN INFORMATION**

Jered LLC is an engineering, manufacturing and project management company that has served both commercial and government markets since it was founded in 1946. Jered is a US corporation, privately owned and a designated small business where US government contracts are concerned. Jered LLC has recently been acquired by PaR Systems, Inc., a company with 45 years of remote handling and robotics experience in hazardous environments.

Jered LLC has a long and successful history in designing and manufacturing equipment and systems for the US Department of Defense with the primary end-user being the US Navy. Jered has established a solid reputation for supplying the highest quality marine equipment (pontoons, cranes, elevators, steering gear, deck machinery, material handling equipment, etc.) Jered adheres to stringent military specifications required by the US Navy, all aspects of Integrated Logistics Support and high level Quality Assurance programs. Jered has been certified to ISO 9001-2000 quality standards since mid 1996 and still retains compliance to MIL-Q-9858A.



## **MANUFACTURING CAPABILITIES**

Jered LLC has provided virtually all of the aircraft elevators for the US Navy, including the CVN 71-77, LHA 1-5, LHD 1-8, LPH 9-12. Jered also provided the aircraft elevators for France's Charles de Gaulle and Spain's Principe de Austrias aircraft carriers. The lift capacity of the aircraft elevators varies depending on the particular ship, with the largest being 200,000 pounds payload on the CVN 76 and 77. The safety and reliability of the Jered aircraft elevators have made them a critical component of aircraft carriers.

In addition to the aircraft elevators, Jered has supplied the steering gear, weapons elevators, and anchor windlass on the CVN class as well as the majority of other US Navy vessels.

## **FACILITIES IN USA**

Jered LLC's administrative offices and manufacturing facilities are located in Brunswick, Georgia, with a satellite engineering office located in Iron Mountain, Michigan. Jered has an employment base of about 100 people. Their employees include experienced engineers and manufacturing personnel and certified welders to Mil-Spec and commercial weld standards. NDT procedures and weld inspectors are also certified.
