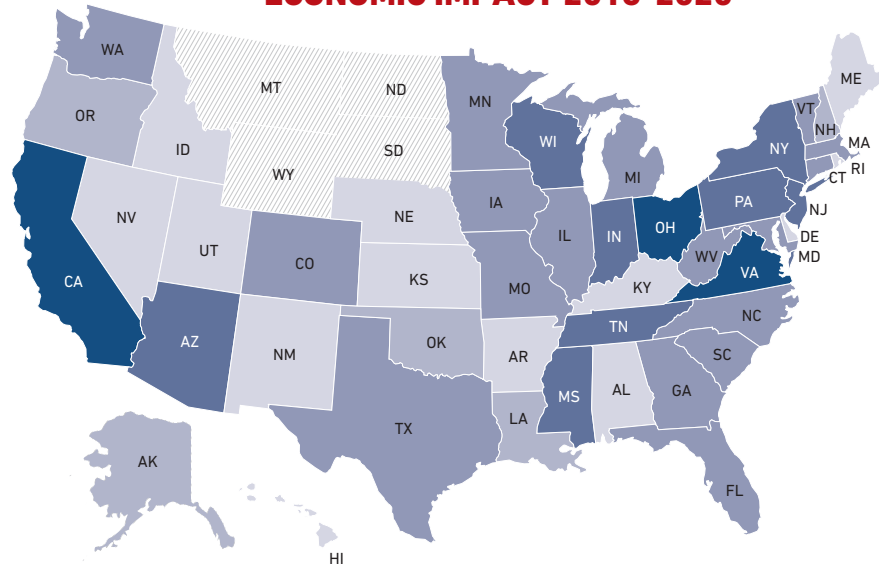

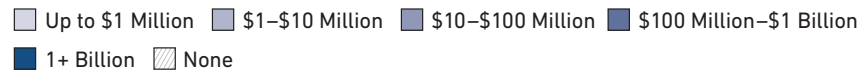

DOLLARS SPENT



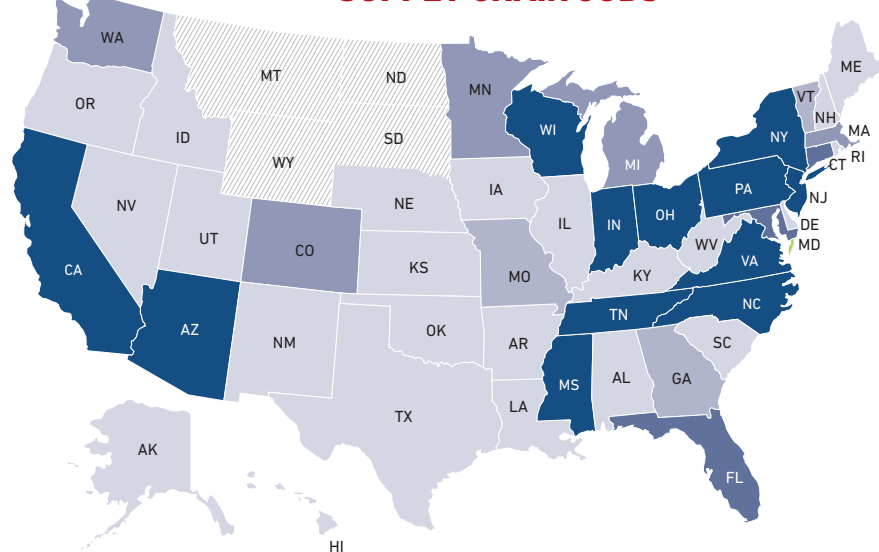
The pandemic changed how we work and in a recent survey, our members highlighted why our industry persevered while other industries struggled to maintain their workforce:
