AS A SUPPLY-CHAIN COMPANY FOR THE U.S. NAVY NUCLEAR-POWERED AIRCRAFT CARRIER PROGRAM (CVN), I RESPECTFULLY REQUEST YOU SUPPORT CONSISTENT, PREDICTABLE AND STABLE FUNDING FOR THE CVN CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM.

SUPPORT THE PRESIDENT'S FY2027 BUDGET REQUEST BY AUTHORIZING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDING FOR AIRCRAFT CARRIER PROGRAMS CURRENTLY UNDER CONTRACT, SPECIFICALLY:

- ★ **Refueling and Complex Overhaul (RCOH) Program funding for USS John C. Stennis (CVN 74) and USS Harry S. Truman (CVN 75)**
- ★ **Carrier Replacement Program funding for John F. Kennedy (CVN 79), Enterprise (CVN 80) and Doris Miller (CVN 81)**
- ★ **Carrier Replacement Program Advance Procurement (AP) funding for CVN 82**

WHY WE NEED TO PRESERVE THE STRENGTH OF THE AIRCRAFT CARRIER FORCE AND INDUSTRIAL BASE

- ★ **A cornerstone of national security:** 11 aircraft carriers provide the nation with its most lethal and compelling global presence and military response assets. The demand for these carriers remains extremely high.
- ★ **Global reach and relentless pace:** In 2025, over half (6 of 11) of the Navy's aircraft carriers were deployed, with operations conducted across all six fleets. The nation's oldest and newest operational carriers, USS Nimitz (CVN 68) and USS Gerald R. Ford (CVN 78), were both deployed, and nearly every recent aircraft carrier deployment has been extended.
- ★ **The Aircraft Carrier Industrial Base Coalition:**
 - Stimulates U.S. economic prosperity
 - Offers untapped domestic industrial capacity
 - Delivers America's Maritime Dominance
- ★ **A majority of these aircraft carrier suppliers:¹**
 - Provide parts for both aircraft carrier and submarine programs
 - Support both current aircraft carrier readiness and new construction efforts
 - Are single or sole-source providers
